ALIENATION OF PROPERTY BY MEANS OF AN UNSOLICITED BID

Notice is hereby given in terms of Section 21 of the Local Government: Municipal Systems Act, 2000, (Act 32 of 2000 as amended) read together with Section 113 of the Local Government: Municipal Finance Management Act, 2003 (Act 56 of 2003) and Section 44 of the Council's Supply Chain Management Policy that the Steve Tshwete Local Municipality intends to donate 8 redundant panels removed from Verdoorn Main Station to Emakhazeni Local Municipality.

The alienation of the panels is not open for competitive bidding because:

- i) The persons who made the proposal will be prejudiced if a competitive bidding process is followed;

- i) The panels are transferred from one municipality to another municipality.
