Tenders are hereby invited for the development and landscaping of Park 11829, located in Mhluzi extension 7 known as node C as well as landscaping in Ngwako Street, Thembisa Section, Mhluzi known as node B in the Steve Tshwete Municipal region. **Tenderers should have a CIDB contractor grading of SH4 or higher.** The contract comprises mainly of **NODE C:** 2 x soccer fields; 2 x multi-purpose courts; tree planting; irrigation and children play areas. **NODE B:** tree planting; concrete tree grids and tree guards.

The tenders will be opened in public.

A **compulsory clarification meeting** with representatives of the Employer will take place at the Steve Tshwete Local Municipality on the 2nd floor, Civic Centre, Wanderers Avenue, Middelburg **on 22 February 2011 starting at 12:00 hrs.** Contract documentation will not be available on site, and the Engineer will not be available for inspection purposes on any other occasion.

A preferential point system shall apply whereby a contract will be allocated to a tenderer in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, Act No 5 of 2000 and as defined in the Conditions of Tender in the tender document, read in conjunction with the Supply Chain Management Policy of Steve Tshwete Local Municipality where 90 points will be allocated in respect of price and 10 points in respect of targeted goals. Tenderers must have the necessary skills, experience and capacity to perform the required work.

- If that person is not a natural person, of which any director, manager, principal shareholder or stakeholder is a person in the service of the state
