Tenders are hereby invited for the construction of an ablution facility at Park 11829, Mhluzi extension 7, known as node C as well as the construction of another ablution facility in Ngwako Street, Thembisa section, Mhluzi known as node B in the Steve Tshwete Municipal region. **Tenderers should have a CIDB contractor grading of 3GBPE, 4GB or higher.** The contract comprises mainly of ablution facilities and site works.

All tender documents must be submitted with the following documents:

- Valid tax Clearance certificate
- Company Registration Certificate

In the case of a joint Venture the following documents are required:

- Joint Venture agreement signed by both parties
- Valid Tax Clearance Certificate of both parties
- Company Registration Certificates of both companies

In awarding the tender the 90/10 preferential point system shall be used.

A compulsory clarification meeting with representatives of the Employer will take place at the Steve Tshwete Local Municipality on the 2nd floor, Municipal Manager's committee room, Civic Centre, Wanderers Avenue, Middelburg on 01 MARCH 2011 at 10:00am. Contract documentation will not be available on site, and the Engineer will not be available for inspection purposes on any other occasion.

A preferential point system shall apply whereby a contract will be allocated to a tenderer in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, Act No 5 of 2000 and as defined in the Conditions of Tender in the tender document, read in conjunction with the Supply Chain Management Policy of Steve Tshwete Local Municipality where 90 points will be allocated in respect of price and 10 points in respect of targeted goals. Tenderers must have the necessary skills, experience and capacity to perform the required work.

No awards will be made to a person:

- Who is in the service of the state,
- If that person is not a natural person, of which any director, manager, principal shareholder or stakeholder is a person in the service of the state
