Contract documentation will not be available on site, and the Project Manager will not be available for inspection purposes on any other occasion.

A preferential point system shall apply whereby a contract will be allocated to a tenderer in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, Act No 5 of 2000 and as defined in the Conditions of Tender in the tender document, read in conjunction with the Supply Chain Management Policy of Steve Tshwete Local Municipality where 90/10 points will be allocated in respect of price and 90/10 points in respect of targeted goals. Tenderers must have the necessary skills, experience and capacity to perform the required work.
