A compulsory clarification meeting with representatives of the Employer will take place at the Traffic boardroom on Tuesday 24.01.2012 at 10:00. The closing time for receipt of tenders is **12:00 hrs on Thursday, 02.02.2012**. Telegraphic, telephonic, telex, facsimile, e-mail and late tenders will not be accepted.

Duly completed tender enclosed in a sealed envelope marked "**TENDER NO. BS14/12/2011: SUPPLY AND INSTALLATION OF NEW AND UPGRADE TRAFFIC LIGHTS**" with the name of the Tenderer, shall be deposited in the tender box provided at the Steve Tshwete Local Municipality on the 2nd floor, Civic Centre, Wanderers Avenue, Middelburg, before **12h00** on the closing date. The tenders will be opened in public.

A preferential point system shall apply whereby a contract will be allocated to a tenderer in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, Act No 5 of 2000 and as defined in the Conditions of Tender in the tender document, read in conjunction with the Supply Chain Management Policy of Steve Tshwete Local Municipality where 80 points will be allocated in respect of price and 20 points in respect of BBBEE Level. Tenderers must have the necessary skills, experience and capacity to perform the required work.

Only tenderers who are registered with the Construction Industry Development Board (CIDB), with a contractor grading of EP3 OR higher, are eligible to have their tenders evaluated. A certificate of contractor Registration issued by the CIDB shall be submitted with the tender. All tender documents must be submitted with the following documents:

- Valid Tax Clearance Certificate.
- Vat Registration Certificate.
- Valid BBBEE Certificate

No awards will be made to a person:

- Who is in the service of the state,
- If that person is not a natural person, of which any director, manager, principal shareholder or stakeholder is a person in the service of the state
- Who is an advisor or consultant contracted with the municipality or municipal entity
